- ❖ District public health systems strengthening



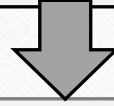


## BACK GROUND

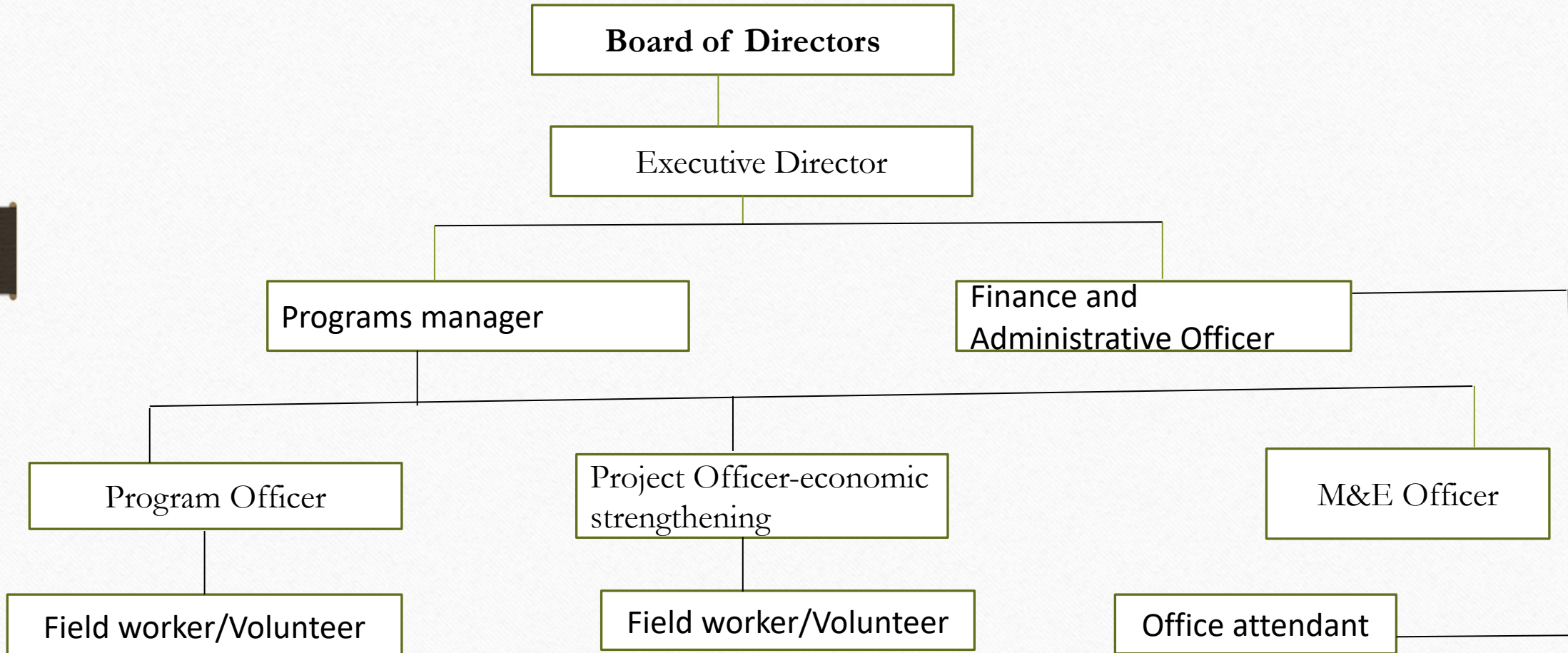
